President, Richard Schwartz called the board meeting to order at 9:00. Board members participating were Giovanni Cosetti, Sherry Edwards, Carolyn Levitski. Richard welcomed members. Mark Dean and Andy Kwas were absent.

<u>Minutes</u> – The minutes from the June 2022 general meeting had been emailed to board members. A motion by Richard Schwartz, seconded by Giovanni Cosetti, to approve the minutes, was passed.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>—Sherry Edwards stated the beginning July balance was \$8,845.02. There were \$190.00 in deposits and expenses of \$890.00 which included Mile High Radio Club \$800 gift, Secetary of State filing of \$20, and Post Office box fee of \$70. The ending balance was \$8,145.02. Thom Wallace moved, and Giovanni Cossetti seconded, to accept the report. Motion approved.

<u>Membership</u>—Pat Hacker reported to Richard by email that currently there are **581 members**, and that 25 RSVPsfor the summer picnic had been received.

<u>Public Relations--</u>Mark Dean Mark was not in attendance, but had indicated that he would be placing two ads for the summer picnic in the Town Crier at the appropriate time.

<u>Roads and Traffic</u>—Richard Schwartz reported that all highways were currently open.

Old Business:

- <u>Summer Picnic</u> committee report. The date remains September 18. A flyer was sent to all Pine Cove residents with the PCWD bill. RSVPs asked for. 25 so far
- <u>Evacuation route signage:</u> Highway 243 signs—Brian Flannigan was not in attendance to speak to this issue. There was discussion about where the signs could be placed, and the creation of a map was suggested. Thom Wallace suggested that MDP could be involved and that Mike Feyder be contacted.
- Committee to add to the Riv Co Good Neighbor Policy, specific to Pine Cove and STR owners. Woody
 Henderson and Jon Brown volunteered.

New Business:

- <u>PCPOA representation in ongoing consideration of 927.1.</u>-- A letter authorizing Woody Henderson and Giovanni
 Cosetti to represent the interests of the Pine Cove Property Association to the ongoing planning commission
 consideration of ordinance 927.1 was presented and approved.
- <u>Christmas Event—</u>Richard Schwartz will make a reservation with Town Hall for December 3, first Saturday in December for the potluck Christmas party. Charge is \$150 to include tables and chairs, and \$150 security deposit.

<u>Comments from Membership</u>—Marge Muir discussed the issue of the lack of input or accountability for the CSA38 funds held by the county. Suggested that a letter be sent to the board of supervisors requesting a report on fund totals and expenditures and possibly requesting that the CSA38 advisory committee be reinstated.
