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

## **Route 243 Mill and Overlay Pavement Safety Work Coming to Mountain Center this Summer 2025**

**RIVERSIDE** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces work on a \$16.9 M pavement safety project on State Route 243 (SR-243). This work is funded through Senate Bill (SB) 1, the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017.

This project will improve road conditions with a pavement mill and overlay, shoulder paving, guardrail enhancements, lighting and sign panel upgrades, storm drainage culvert improvements, and curb ramp upgrades to Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards to improve access for those with disabilities as part of Complete Streets elements. These elements aim to ensure safe accessibility for all roadway users.

Construction signs have been placed in the project zone, as well as clearing in shoulder areas and placement of high visibility fencing for environmentally protected areas. Work operations will occur near Idyllwild, Pine Cove, and Fern Valley from the State Route 74 Junction near Mountain Center to Interstate 10 Junction near Banning. Project work is expected to be complete by winter 2026. All work is weather and material dependent.




Figure 1 July 2025 State Route 243

**Week of September 14<sup>th</sup> Work Schedule:** Several daytime work activities with lane closures and flagging operations will occur various locations on SR-243 throughout the week between the hours 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday. The work activities include upgrading the new storm drainage system near Pine Crest Ave. At the same time, removing and replacing guardrail operations will also begin from Lakeview Dr to Black Mountain Trail. Night and weekend work may occasionally be required from 8:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. for weeknight and from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. for weekend.




Figure 2 Pine Crest Ave Map Location




Figure 5 Guardrail installations Map Location
